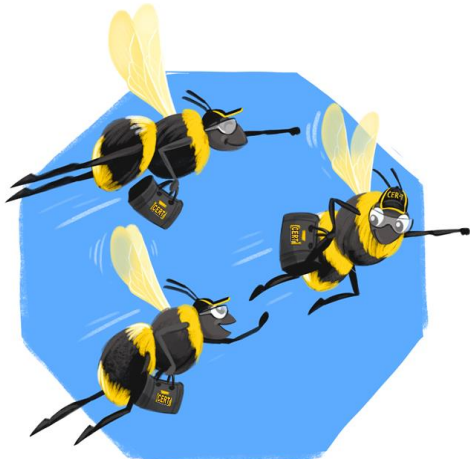


# CERT TRAINING

## COMMUNITY EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAM (CERT)

Basic training provides individuals with the skills and knowledge to respond to their family and community's immediate needs in the aftermath of a disaster. When emergency services are over-whelmed, CERT trained members work together to reduce injuries and loss of life and protect property. Community preparedness will enhance the ability of individuals and neighbourhoods to minimize their emergency needs and to manage their existing resources until professional assistance becomes available.

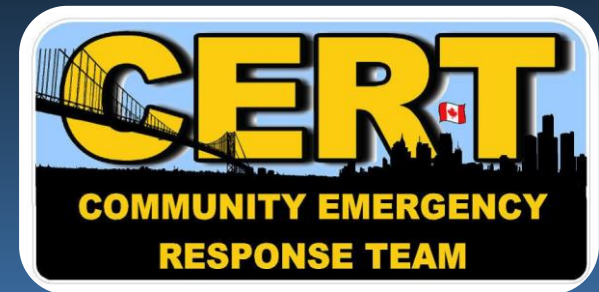
