The devastating summer wildfires that caused havoc for several Alberta communities, motivated Bridges of Love to develop an on-line platform to facilitate the donation process.

Alberta Recovers streamlines administrations to improve overall efficiency when assisting those impacted by loss of home, property, and personal belongings.. Bridges of Love's program, matches donations with disaster victims, with Faith Emergency Preparedness Initiative (FEPI) churches assisting with deliveries, spiritual counsel, etc. Churches helping Neighbours

Disaster management has been a difficult process to monitor, with mounds of donated items often stock-piled. This site eliminates the need to warehouses or store mounds of donated items which may or may not be needed by those who have lost home and possessions. An on-line donation site eliminates the need for a store-

house, as those who have donations hang on to them, until a match is made.

Alberta Recovers is patterned after the disaster donation model pioneered by RECOVERS.ORG. After the 2013 Alberta Flood, Bridges of Love was fortunate to have a dedicated website shared by RECOVERS and it worked like a charm! Bridges of Love matched hundreds of items from automobiles to furnaces and everything in between!

Our initial focus for this platform was the wildfire recovery response but due to a recent Tornado outside the town of Didsbury, the process of adapting the site to address both disaster recovery efforts, is well on its way.

Bridges of Love thanks Timothy Rugg, our summer Computer Science U of A student for his tremendous work, completing this site in a timely fashion so we can proceed at the speed of trust!
