Isaiah 43:19 focuses on God's promise to do something new, urging people to look past hardships and trust His power to create paths and provision in impossible situations, symbolised by making "a way in the wilderness, and rivers in the desert," highlighting hope, transformation, and God's unfailing presence even in barren or difficult times. It's a call to spiritual awareness, recognising God's current work instead of being stuck in past disappointments or expectations, bringing renewal and a way forward.

We are praying God is doing a "New Thing" in and through Bridges of Love; something unprecedented, a fresh work beyond past experiences, a miraculous transformation and renewal. The verse follows a call not to dwell on former glories or troubles, but to anticipate God's current actions. The imagery of "rivers in the desert" signifies God's ability to bring life, refreshment, and sustenance where there seems to be none. God knows our struggles and challenges, knowing exactly how to overcome!

Isaiah 43:19 is a great verse for the start of the New Year, encouraging us to look to the future and all that He has planned. God wants His Followers to trust and obey Him to accomplish His Agenda in all things!
